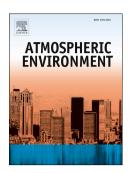



Dense aloft smoke plume intrusion and mixing down into PBL are observed. A coincident increase of ground PM<sub>2.5</sub> in the NYC urban/rural area and the enhancement of OC, EC and K<sup>+</sup> indicate the big impacts of transported smoke on the local air quality.



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
