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

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## ABSTRACT

Bioturbation structures from Ponta das Bicudas in Santiago Island, Cape Verde Archipelago are located in coarse-grained biocalcicrudite sandwiched between basaltic lavas of the Upper Pleistocene Assomada Formation. Four ichnospecies have been

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
