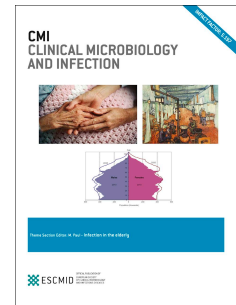

CMI Website Collections

Several new and helpful features have been added to the recently redesigned CMI website (1). One of these important new features is the Collections tab. Our Collections currently include Guideline, Position, and Consensus Papers; Systematic Reviews; How to... Articles; Editorial Policies; MDR Bacteria; Antibiotic Stewardship; Emerging Infections; Viral Infections; and Fungal Infections.

The CMI website now offers alert options via email when new articles are published and added to these Collections. If you have subscribed to the CMI website, you are also given the opportunity to choose which Collections you would like to receive alerts for, according to your interests, field, and preferences. These alert options can be accessed with the following steps:

1. First, Login at the top right hand of the CMI website
<http://www.clinicalmicrobiologyandinfection.com/>
2. Enter your Login Email/Username and Password.
3. Select Collections at the top left hand of the homepage.
4. Select the Collection category you would like to view first.
5. Select Latest Content Alert at the top of the left hand column. This will bring you to the Collection Alerts tab under My Account, which can also be accessed from the very top of the page. Here you can manage your alert preferences, which email address you would like the alerts sent to, and remove alerts from selected Collections. Collection alerts are sent out monthly and will keep you up to date with the latest content that has been added to your chosen subject areas.
6. You are also welcome to select how often you would like to receive alerts for articles in press under the Journal Alerts tab. Remember to Save Changes once you have marked your preferences.

The Collections serve as an important tool for a several reasons. First, they create a useful educational resource that is helpful for people in training (2). In the Guidelines, Position, and Consensus Papers Collection you will find papers important for your practice; such as the update of treatment options for *Clostridium difficile* (3); or on the use of nebulized antimicrobials (4). In the "How to..." Articles Collection you will find practical pointers; such as how to organize a stool bank (5). The alert option will inform you when a new article pertinent to your practice and research is published.

Second, the Collections helpfully organize manuscripts into categories, making it easy to find articles that are of interest to you. Signing up for alerts will further help you to receive the latest information as soon as it is published. Additionally, all of the articles included in these Collections are recent articles, within
