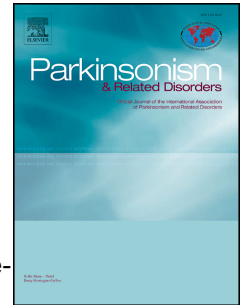


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***Bdnf* Variant is Associated with Milder Motor Symptom Severity in Early-Stage Parkinson's Disease**
