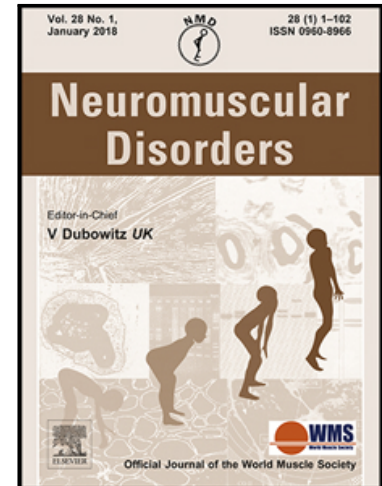


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Respiratory insight to congenital muscular dystrophies and congenital myopathies and its relation to clinical trial

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Highlights

- All children with congenital myopathies should have regular respiratory muscle tests.
- Respiratory muscle tests should privilege natural maneuvers such as sniff and cough.
- Respiratory muscle tests should be adapted to the “respiratory muscle phenotype”.
- Respiratory muscle function should be assessed on a combination of complementary tests.

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
