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# **Article Types**

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The manuscript should be organized in the order listed below. Failure to follow this format may result in the manuscript being returned to the author(s) for revision prior to review.

The title page, abstract, keywords, abbreviations, text, acknowledgements, references, tables and figure legends should be included in one word-processing file (in .doc or .wpd format). Figures should be loaded as separate files in the format specified below.

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  - **Background**: What is the major problem that prompted the study?
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**Please note:** Abbreviations in the title and abstract are not acceptable. Even if they are included in the list of abbreviations, they should be spelled out in those locations.

6. *Text*. The manuscript should be written in clear and concise English. Authors whose primary language is not English should obtain assistance with writing to avoid grammatical problems. **The text should be organized in sections as follows:** *Introduction, Methods, Results*, and *Discussion*. Each section should begin on a new page. The generic terms for all drugs and chemicals should be used.

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
