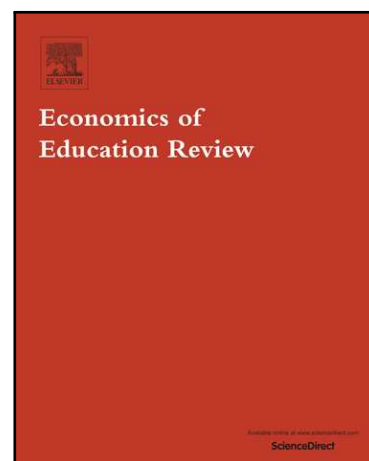


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Private Schools and Student Learning Achievements in Kenya

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Highlights

- We assess the effect of private schools on skill acquisition among children in Kenya.
- We apply estimation approaches that deal with the endogeneity of school choice.
- We find significant private school advantage throughout all these methodologies.
- For instance, in maths, the effect is 0.13 score SD using household FE model.
- Similarly, in language, the effect is 0.21 score SD using the household FE model.

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
